Lucy's Story



Every rescue dog has a story, but few have a story like Lucy's.

Lucy was about 6 months old when she was found swimming through a flooded neighborhood in Harvey's immediate wake. A woman – a

mom – who had previously evacuated, had tried to return to her home to grab a few personal items. She couldn't reach her home because of the water, but she did see a small tan pup, all alone swimming around. She called to the exhausted dog, put her in her car, and the two headed back to the safety of dry land.

Ultimately, the family decided to keep this sweet young pup, and named her Lucy. Lucy was loved and well cared for in her family. She played gently with their children, ate regular and nutritious meals, was showered with love and attention, and saw the vet for routine care. Lucy had a limp, but the vet reassured her family that it was from an old, poorly healed break, and that it did not seem to be causing her any discomfort. Family life proceeded happily for everyone – including lucky and sweet Lucy - for about a year.

Tragedy struck when Lucy's 10-year-old human sibling got sick. He was eventually diagnosed with aplastic anemia. The family quickly found themselves living in doctor's offices and hospitals as their son's condition deteriorated. They were terrified of losing their son, and simply did not have the time at home to care for Lucy. They reached out hoping that Lucy could be taken in by a rescue. It broke their hearts to let Lucy go, but it was the only decision they could make at that time.

Thankfully, Chances Dog Rescue and Relocation was able to help with Lucy, and their son was able to get prepared for a bone marrow transplant. At the end of November, Lucy took the long ride to Cape Ann Animal Aid in Massachusetts with over 30 other dogs.


She settled in nicely, but after a few days staff noticed her limp and referred her to their staff vet for an evaluation. The vet noted that Lucy seemed to be in some pain and was experiencing arthritis and muscle loss. They performed x-rays, and to everyone's horror, discovered a bullet was lodged in Lucy's upper leg. They hypothesized that the bullet wound is what caused Lucy's original limping – way back before her Hurricane Harvey rescue, when she was just a young pup.

The decision was made to amputate her leg to preserve her muscle use and strength on her opposite leg, and to alleviate her suffering. Lucy awoke and recovered from the surgery beautifully. She was happy and adjusted to be a tri-pod without issue. After some TLC from staff and a final check from their vet, Lucy was ready to hit the adoption floor to find her very own forever family. She didn't have to wait long. The next day she was adopted! (In January, Lucy's former human sibling received a bone marrow transplant as well, and is on the path to recovery himself...)

We were so happy to be able to help Lucy and her family when they needed us, and we are incredibly grateful to work with amazing and compassionate northern partners like Cape Ann Animal Aid.
